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#### Improvisation in music is really quite simple.

(Almost anyone can do it, I swear.)

You need to be able to...

Understand music theory

Be proficient with building and producing:

- Chords
- Chord progressions
- Melody structure

Create intervals and sequences

Use melodies within a scale, play arpeggios, and understand the variation of tones available within those structures

All while sounding very natural and appealing

Deep roots, wide applications, huge impacts


The impact of jazz and blues is incalculable.



#### 2000s: Music sharing becomes popular


Indie bands continue to rise even more because music sharing becomes popular.







#### **Getting started**

To be a great improvisor, you need to establish some rules.

Good improvision allows us to find new territory quickly.

Improvising can lead to incredible connection with your audience/team.

It makes us better communicators.

It creates the opportunity for psychological safety, and that can lead to better relationships.

Improvisation can reinforce and build community within your teams and organizations—because it has more to do with listening and observing than creating.

If we become experts at finding threads and taking risks, those threads will become our safety net.
